We call upon your attention to the following as we prepare to report for the term:-

1. The students shall report on **30/03/2021** from **8:00 am up to 4:00 pm**. Please abide to avoid inconveniences.
2. A student shall only be allowed 2 escorts at most and they should be willing to observe the set Covid SOPs.

3. School Fees

Every student should report with a fully paid-up bank slip of **shs. 1.300.000/=**. Please use the school number indicated on her identity card to pay e.g. NGS-20-S1-**020**, You can use the usual **School Pay System** or pay directly to the school **Account No. 9030005843374 or 9030005843382** in Stanbic bank.

4. Special Academic Programme

Due to the amount of academic work that has to be done within this short time and also due to the fact that Nabisunsa Girls' School is a UNEB Marking Centre for O'Level, the S.1 final term has been designed as follows;

30th March – 23rd April – 1st session.

24th April – 29th May – Half term holiday session to allow for UNEB Marking.

30th May – 24th July – Final session.

5. Medical Check-Ups

No student shall be allowed into school without a medical check-up form from **KIBULI MUSLIM HOSPITAL**.

6. Face Shields/Masks

Every student should have a face shield and 3 reusable NGS face masks.

Please note:

- NGS branded reusable face masks shall be bought at school at 12,000/= (***Twelve thousand shillings only***) for a set of 3 masks.
- Face shields shall also be available at school sold at 13,000/= each.

7. Prayer Mat

Every Muslim Student should bring a small personal prayer mat for use in the mosque as a precautionary measure against Covid-19.

8. Other Personal Requirements:

Please note that there shall not be any sharing of items allowed, be it in class or in the dormitory. Likewise, school utensils shall not be used in the dining hall, hence every student shall be required to present the following personal items for checking on the reporting day in addition to the usual requirements:

- ✓ Face Shield (1)
- ✓ Reusable face masks (3)
- ✓ Plate (1)
- ✓ Vacuum cup / flask (1)
- ✓ Spoon (1), Fork (1)
- ✓ Water bottle (1)
- ✓ Hankies (at least 6)

9. Visitation Days

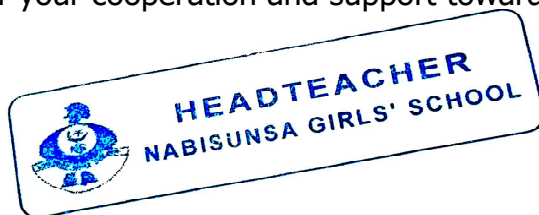
